to Follow

A. But Muhammad is a law unto himself!

- 1. Only he could marry more than 4 wives (Surah 4:3; 33:50).
- 2. Only he could defer or take wives at his whim (Surah 33:51).
- 3. He should be addressed above other Muslim men (Surah 33:56).
- 4. He deserves special etiquette (Surah 33:53).
- B. Jesus sought no special favors and is the example to follow!
 - 1. He humbled Himself (Phil. 2:7-8).
 - 2. He experienced trial & temptation (Heb. 2:17; 4:15).
 - 3. He lived consistent with His own teaching & all law of Moses (Matt. 5:17-18).
 - 4. He challenged His enemies to name His sin (John 8:46).
